TOWN OF DELTA ORDINANCE NO. 07-1 DRIVEWAY/ACCESS ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Delta, Bayfield County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section I. Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to establish standards for driveways that will provide for safe and adequate access from private property to the public right-of-way.

Section II. Statutory Authority

This ordinance is adopted as authorized under s. 60.61, 60.62 and 62.23 Stats. and through the granted village powers pursuant to s. 60.10 and the town meeting dated February 22, 2007 approving the authority of the Town Board of the Town of Delta to zone pursuant to s. 60.62 Stats.

Section III. Requirements

All new driveways proposed to be installed or any driveway alleged to be existing and serving open land without improvements and proposed to be converted to a driveway to serve one or more structures shall be subject to an inspection by the Town Board or the Town Board's designee prior to the start of any construction on a new driveway and to the issuance of a building permit. An approved driveway permit shall be in place before a building permit can be issued.

The applicant shall submit a location construction plan showing specifications including grade, slope, width and length of the driveway and erosion control procedures.

Authorization for a driveway is subject to the approval of the Town Board of Delta and when so approved the Town Board shall notify the Bayfield County Zoning office. A statement from the Town Board that an approved driveway is in place will determine the evidence of an existing driveway. If there is a dispute on the adequacy of an alleged existing driveway, the decision of the Town Board shall be the deciding factor.

All driveways installed, altered, changed, replaced, or extended shall meet the following requirements and must be approved as to location by the Town.

The following minimum specifications shall apply to all new driveways installed after April 1, 2007

Minimum road surface width	16 feet
Minimum width clearance	24 feet
Minimum height clearance free of trees, wires, etc	14 feet
Maximum grade	10 %

It is recommended by the Town Board that all single dwelling driveways meet the above requirements for the home owner's safety and fire protection services. The Town of Delta will not take on any driveway for the purpose of snowplowing if the driveway does not meet the above minimum specifications.

All driveways within the area of the public right-of-way shall meet the minimum specifications stated above and shall slope away from the public highway a sufficient amount and distance to prevent erosion. A roadbed base of suitable material to support the projected traffic and any requirements of culverts shall be determined by the town in considering an application. If a culvert is required by the Town Road Supervisor, the recommended minimum diameter shall be 12" and minimum length shall be 30' with end walls at the right-of-way entrance. At the deadend of all new driveways, a turnaround of at least 25 feet radius or some other method to allow vehicles to turn around shall be provided as determined by the town.

All driveways shall be constructed in accordance with the above requirements and other specifications as may be set forth by the Town Board. The maintenance of the driveway shall be the responsibility of the applicant and/or the property owner.

The applicant for a Town Driveway Permit or a Town Highway Access Permit must provide to the Town Clerk a completed application with the appropriate non-refundable fee. The applicant must also submit a sketch of proposed driveway including grade, slope, width and length of driveway and indicate turnouts if required and the dead-end turnaround. The applicant or designee should be available at the appropriate Town Board Meeting to answer questions or submit clarification, to better expedite the permit process.

The applicant, his/her successors or assigns agree to hold harmless the Town of Delta and it's duly appointed agents and employees against any action for personal injury or property damage sustained by reason of the exercise of this permit.

Section IV. Severability

If any term of this Agreement is declared by a court having jurisdiction to be illegal or unenforceable, the validity of the remaining terms shall not be affected, and, if possible, the rights and obligations of the parties are to be construed and enforced as if the Agreement did not contain that term
